
# 2-Day Workshop on Psychological First Aid & Psychological Recovery by Dr. Melissa Brymer & Prof. Robert Pynoos

**Professor Robert Pynoos** (right) is the Special Consultant of the American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Task Force on Crisis and Disaster Preparedness. Professor Pynoos specializes in adopting the PFA for children and adolescents.



Psychological First Aid (PFA) has become the standard of practice in the immediate aftermath of mass casualty events, with recommendation of the ISAC Guidelines on Mental Health and Psychosocial Support in Emergency Settings. PFA is an evidence-informed acute intervention for children, adults, and families impacted by disasters and terrorism. It is designed to reduce the initial distress caused by disasters and to foster short- and long-term adaptive functioning and coping. Participants will review how to implement PFA in different settings and address how staff of different disciplines can all take a role in acute crises. Skills for Psychological Recovery (SPR) will also be discussed. SPR is an evidence-informed modular approach to help children, adolescents, adults, and families in the weeks and months after disasters beyond the period where PFA is utilized. SPR is a strength-based skills-training model designed to accelerate recovery, enhance coping, and increase self-efficacy. Participants will actively practice these skills and learn how to adapt them with culturally diverse populations and in different settings.

Day One: 16 September 2010 (Thur) (0845-1700) Modernizing Disaster Mental Health and Acute Disaster Response: Providing Psychological First Aid (PFA)

- Overview of modern principles and strategies for public disaster mental health response and recovery
- Understand the eight basic objectives and intervention strategies of PFA
- Adaptation of PFA in diverse settings including schools, hospitals, shelters and community settings

Day Two: 17 September 2010 (Fri) (0845-1700) Resilience and Recovery: Applying Skills for Psychological Recovery (SPR)

- Review of the six core empirically-derived skill sets and will engage participants in practicing SPR
- Identify the basic objectives and intervention strategies of SPR
- Adaptation of SPR in diverse settings including schools, hospitals, shelters and community settings
