Day 1

Implication of brain injury & environmental factors for cognitive, social and behavioural development

1. Neurones to neighbourhoods: importance of environment on early child development
2. Impact of trauma, abuse and maltreatment on brain development and functional outcomes
3. Attention, social and behaviour as common outcomes of early brain injury/trauma with neural underpinnings which would inform interventions (parenting & treatment for child)

Day 2

Clinical practice driven by neuropsychological evidence for children with early brain injury/trauma (may involve small group work in the session with content covered in Day 1 as background)

1. Information and demonstration of assessment
2. Child, parenting and parent mental health interventions
3. Children with chronic illness, acquired brain injury, ADHD etc.
