Prof. Bisson developed an interest in traumatic stress during his time in the British Army and leads Cardiff University's Traumatic Stress Research Group. He is a member of Cardiff University's Violence Research Group, which was awarded a 2009 Queen's Anniversary Prize. He has conducted two widely cited RCTs of early psychological interventions following traumatic events and Cochrane systematic reviews in the traumatic stress field. He was co-chair of the Guideline Development Group for the UK's NICE guideline on the management of PTSD in primary and secondary care and chair of the Update Group. He has published 97 peer-reviewed papers. He is a past president of *the European Society for Traumatic Stress Studies* and chair of the Global Meetings Committee of the *International Society for Traumatic Stress Studies*.
